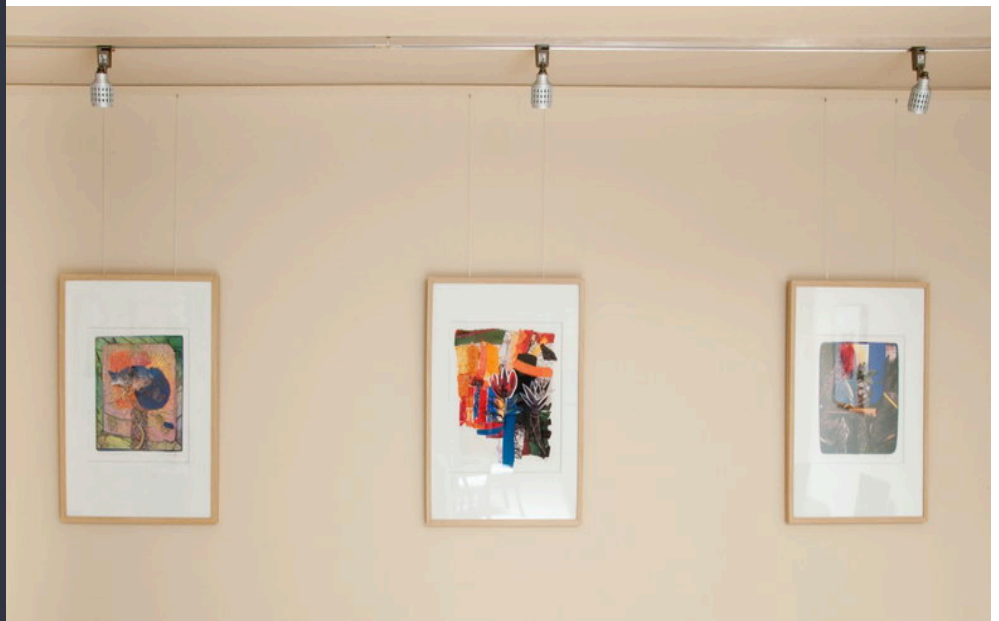

About the NHS Exhibition Space

infusing art through learning and collaboration

The idea for the **NHS Exhibition Space** came from ongoing conversations with fellow North High teachers over the past couple of years. These conversations gave birth to the idea of seeking a space that would allow each teacher the opportunity to showcase their student artwork in a professional environment.

The space that seemed to make most sense at North High School was the corridor between the computer lab wing and the World Languages wing.

The corridor is 11.5 feet wide with a potential exhibition wall measuring 44 feet. Along the top of the wall will be a gallery hanging system (see above image), which will allow each teacher the flexibility to install the artwork while providing opportunities for proper space. Height for each piece of art can also be adjusted.

Listed above are three levels in which North High teachers can participate. The art department will handle the scheduling



of the exhibition calendar. Interested teachers are responsible for installing and deinstalling their own work by the stipulated deadlines. Student work can be on display from 3 weeks to 6 weeks depending up teacher needs.
