

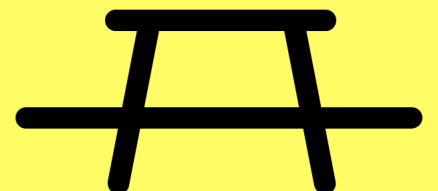

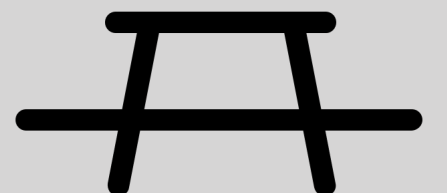

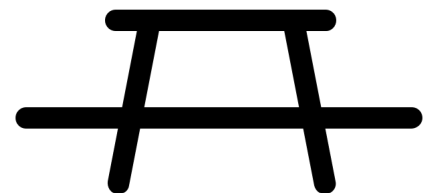
Project Summary

- provide a place to study or get inspired by the environment around us.



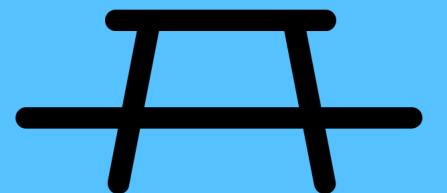
Goal(s)

- promote creativity.



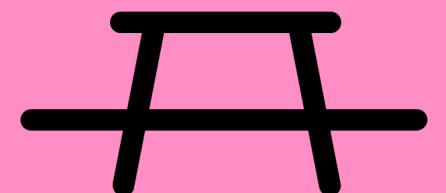
Proposed Locations

- one by the circle of stones outside the auditorium.



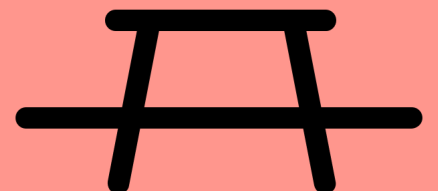
Procedure
